#### MANOMIN RESAWN TIMBERS FOREST LAKE, MINN.

**COMMENTS:** This end-grain floor, which was milled into various-sized blocks from reclaimed, 100-year-old Douglas fir timbers, was pieced together like a puzzle and stained antique brown to pop the ring patterns.

**COMMENTS:** For the floor, Southern yellow pine decking material recovered from a mill circa 1880 was ski-planed and custom-milled into 5¼-inch wide flooring, and all high edges were hand-scraped and stained to blend in with the antique faces.
